In april I was feeling run down so i went to the doctor and found out that i was expecting again and immediatly broke down, my doctor assured me that every precaution was going to be taken

Well here is the update.... On Dec 20 I gave birth to a little girl Kristina Michelle weighing 4 pound 9 oz AND Alexander Thomas weighing 4 pounds 8 oz both healthy and thriving

My son Matthew will never be forgotten he will always be my baby boy but was needed in heaven
