If they think they can compete for part of the market share by airing something else, they will. At least that is how our local station operates. Especially in that it won't be anything but a gap filler for something else that replaces it in the fall.

The 10th of Sept. is actually a Sunday and the fall season debuts usually kicks in around mid September on a Sunday or Monday. Heck, we'll be starting to see promotions for the new shows in June most likely to start building an interest in new programming.
