When they were doing the on camera commentary pieces, she was pretty forthright with her criticisms of things he said and how he said them.. The poor guy probably feels like he can't do anything right?

Having sextuplets are stressful enough and a pair of twins on top of that.. without the control issues and phobias.. I couldn't believe that she'd go behind someone to check for dust in nooks and crannies amidst all that chaos. I would be grateful if someone just did nuts and bolts cleaning and picking up. She was being very unrealistic given the circumstances. Who would want to work for someone like that.

She made a couple of comments about him taking off and I think it was real.

Their unhappiness was apparent in their first documentary. I thought it was real then too. If you'll remember they took the entire family to the pumpkin patch for photos. The kids were very tired and ill and mom was very opinionated in how she wanted things to go. The kids did not want to cooperate and Hubby was distant and fed up with the entire thing. Mom made everybody endure and finally got the perfect photo she wanted.

It was the first show about families with multiple births that made me say, Wow, what a miserable life. Of course, the kids seem to be quite happy and well adjusted. I do feel for the twins. I think they get looked over a lot. It was great last night, the couple got to take a short trip with the twins to California. That was quite a trip for them. They actually had friends who cared for the other kids while they went on this trip.

Other people notice their anger as well. Last night, her sister in law, said that of course the couple uses sharp language towards each other, but then, they just move on as if nothing happened. I think she was trying to convince the viewers that things are alright.
