I remember on the Real World Key West, one of the girls was really messed up mentally and suffered from a serious eating disorder, plus she had a terrible drinking problem. Finally, the show got her into a therapist right there in Key West. She went while she was on the show. She later said they saved her life. I think they were afraid of liability if they didn't do something. However they try to absolve themselves from liability by getting signed waivers, the waiver probably won't save them if the negligence is very bad.

I guess in any setting like that you encounter people who are very bad off and need inhouse care. I think that might be hard to do if you have a group ready to get wild and party. I think the SO house even ran into problems when they allowed the "little" partying that they did with the wine drinking. I think many people would not bother applying to go on a show that would restrict so very much about them, so as having a glass of wine with dinner.

As if appears Bad Girls Club is coming back, they should get some structure in the house and offer if not insist on a life coach.
